Itinerary

- **Day 1: New York– New Haven – New Port– Boston:**
Depart from NYC in the morning for the tree lined campus of Yale University. Stroll along the grounds of this centuries old ivy-league institution. After lunch, the tour continues to Newport in Rhode Island, crossing the famous Newport Bridge to visit the Breaker Mansion. At Breaker Mansion, visitors can experience the past wealth of America's Gilded Age. Built for Cornelius Vanderbilt, the 11-acre estate features entire rooms that were crafted in Europe and shipped to the building site, as well as prime examples of Renaissance art. The tour arrives in Boston in the evening, where we will have the opportunity to visit downtown Boston and Quincy Market. Situated between Boston's financial district, the waterfront, North End, Government Center and Haymarket, the vibrant Quincy Market is one of America's oldest gathering place. There will also be an opportunity to partake in Boston's most famous export – the lobster– during dinner.
- **Day 2: Boston - New York:**
We continue our tour of Boston in the morning by visiting the pristine campuses of Harvard and MIT, both world-class educational institutions. We will also visit prominent sites in Boston such as the State House, built between 1795 and 1797 on Beacon Hill overlooking the Boston Common, and recently featured in the major Hollywood film "The Departed." The tour will head to Mother Church and Trinity Church, both major centers for Christian faith in America and sites of powerful examples of religious architecture. There will also be an opportunity for a whale watching tour (seasonal), where you can view some of the world's most fascinating and magnificent creatures in their natural habitat. The tour returns to New York in the evening.
